**ORDINANCE NO. 2021-19
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CITY CODE 5-4-2(D)1**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF WOODLAND HILLS, UTAH: CITY CODE 5-4-2(D)1-
Fire Sprinklers be amended to read:

Fire Sprinkler Systems. All new construction of any structure and construction that constitutes more than 50% expansion of any structure shall include an automatic fire sprinkler system which complies with the Fire Code, National Fire Protection Association 13D requirements, and related regulations and standards adopted by the City, modified as follows:

(a) Fire sprinklers shall be required in all heated areas, living areas, garages, and mechanical or furnace rooms except:

(iv) In a detached garage separated from the dwelling unit or main building by more than 20 feet and having a floor area of less than 200 square feet.

(b) Sprinkling [systems shall be provided with an exterior inspector's test port which is a Woodford Model 65 (exposed type) or B65 wall hydrant or that complies with other specifications or other material approved by the Fire Chief.

(c) Both interior and exterior water flow alarm devices are required. Location will be approved by the Fire Chief.
